Superintendent's Message to the Board,

Board members, It has been a great month and we are quickly approaching Christmas break at close to mid year.

This past week I was able to attend a job career fair in Bozeman with Mr. Wison. We had yet to attend the event at the time of writing of this document, but we wanted to recruit for our two open certified positions as well as gain knowledge and experience on recruiting at job fairs as job fairs seem to be a possible route to hiring more teachers in our district. Most states have career fairs for teachers and this is an opportunity we would like to explore locally before evaluating the positives and negatives of visiting a job fair.

Rick Cumings and I attended a School Saftey and Security Symposium in Helena this past week. The purpose of the symposium was to increase training and awareness regarding school crisis and safety. We have several resources available updating our security and crisis plan within our crisis team. If any board member is interested in being a member of the crisis team in charge of our safety and security policies and protocols, please let me know as we will be meeting monthly to update those plans and documents.

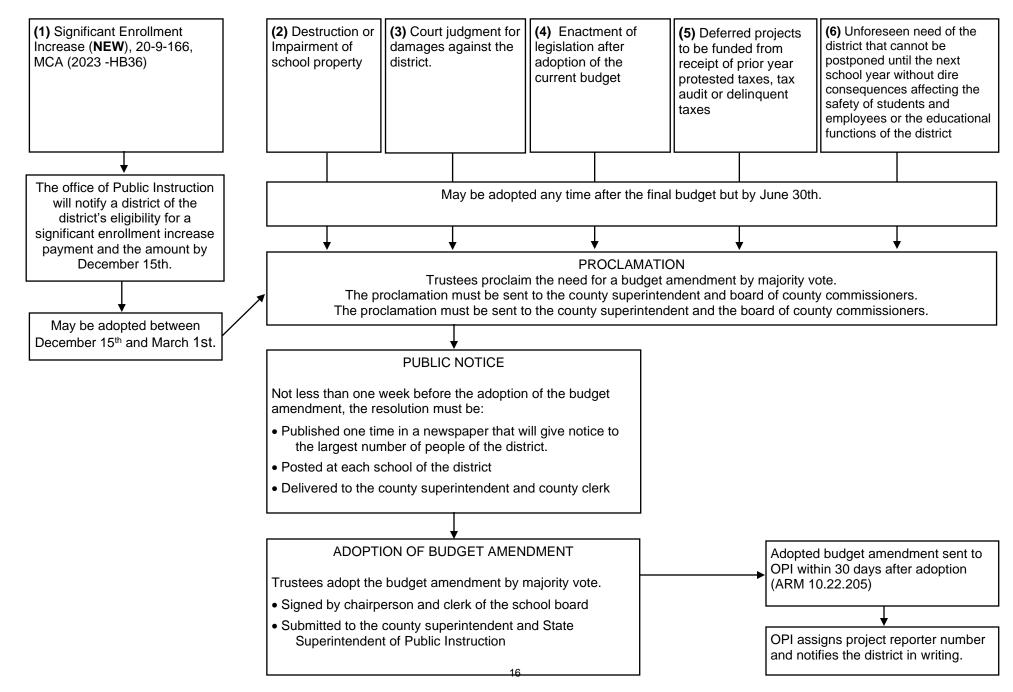

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of School District No.3B, Cascade County, Montana, will meet at 6 p.m. at Cascade Public Schools on January 16, 2024 for the purpose of considering and adopting the budget amendment.

Mortag commented that there are other facility upgrades that need to be done. She inquired

about a policy for sponorships, as well as the need for a fundraising committee.

Cummings commented that the sponsorships need to be tacked down.

McKamey commented that sponsorships need to be in place and would like to wait for the quotes from daktronics to come in.

Kendra Lane made public comment on the other needs in school.

Lawni Raether made public comment about the ability to add in an educational component, current curriclum that needs addressed in school and the possibility that we may not get as many sponorships with analog scoreboard.

Mark McKamey moved to table the motion. Ruth Mortag seconded.

McKamey made comment that there were a lot of upcoming expenses and the purchase needed to thought through more, as well as firmed up prices.

Mortag commented that she would like to see a precommitment from sponsors with a dollar range for contribution. The policy commitee should creat a framework of sponsorship packages. Cummings reiterated the importance of sponsorships.

The board directed the administration to bring more information to the January board meeting. Passed unanimously.
